

## **Temporary Closure Scheduled for Interstate 90 Exit 59 Westbound On-Ramp in Rapid City**

RAPID CITY, S.D. – The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) says the Interstate 90 westbound entrance ramp at Exit 59 (N LaCrosse Street) in Rapid City will be closed beginning at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Nov. 3, 2022 to all vehicle traffic. Westbound motorists are requested to follow the detours, and use Exit 58 at Haines Avenue, as an alternate route.

This closure is anticipated to be in place through Wednesday, Nov. 23, 2022 to allow crews to construct the westbound on-ramp tie-in to N LaCrosse Street. Motorists and pedestrians are asked to be aware of construction workers and equipment in the westbound I-90 Exit 59 vicinity.

This is the second year of the project to reconstruct the interchange on I-90 at Exit 59 (N LaCrosse Street). Complete Contracting of Rapid City is the prime contractor on the \$17 million project. The overall completion date of this project is June 2023.
